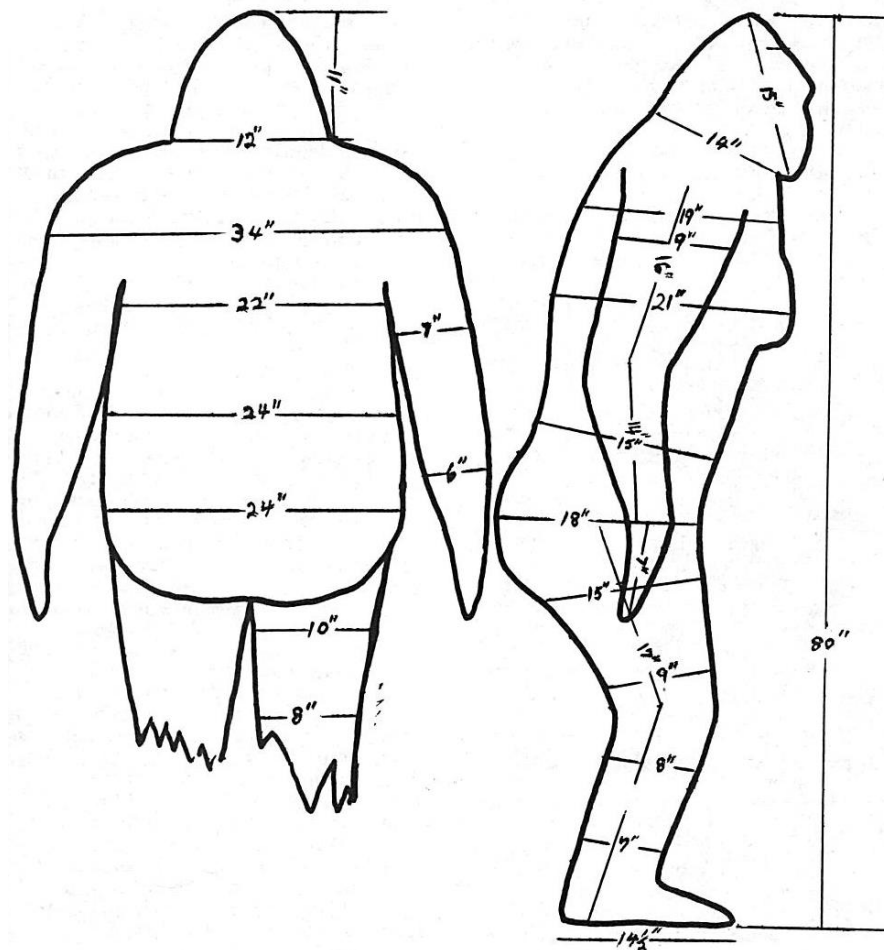






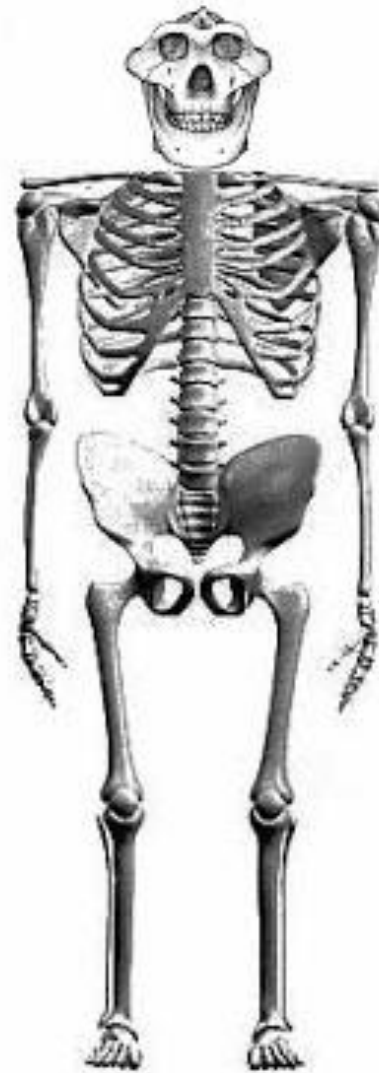
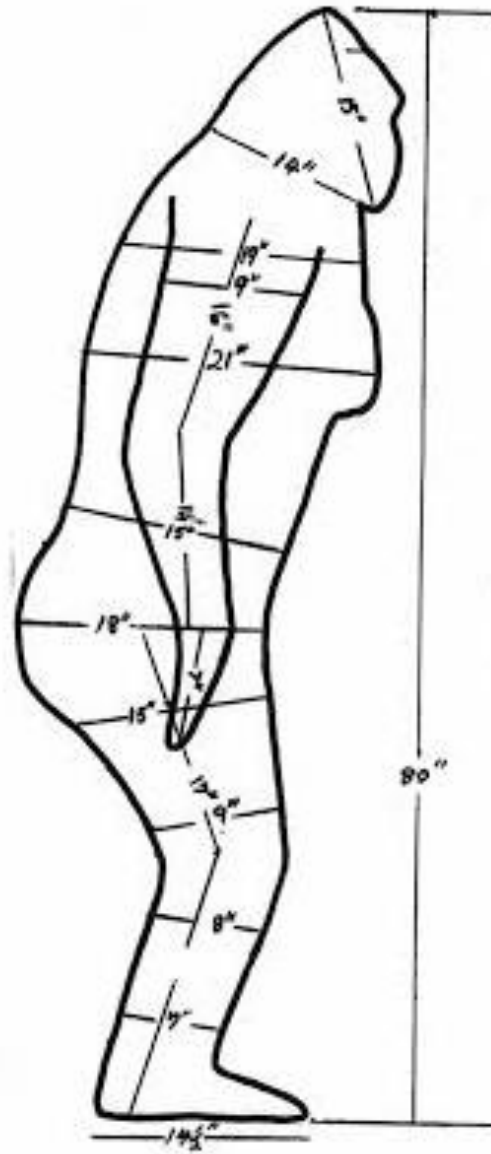


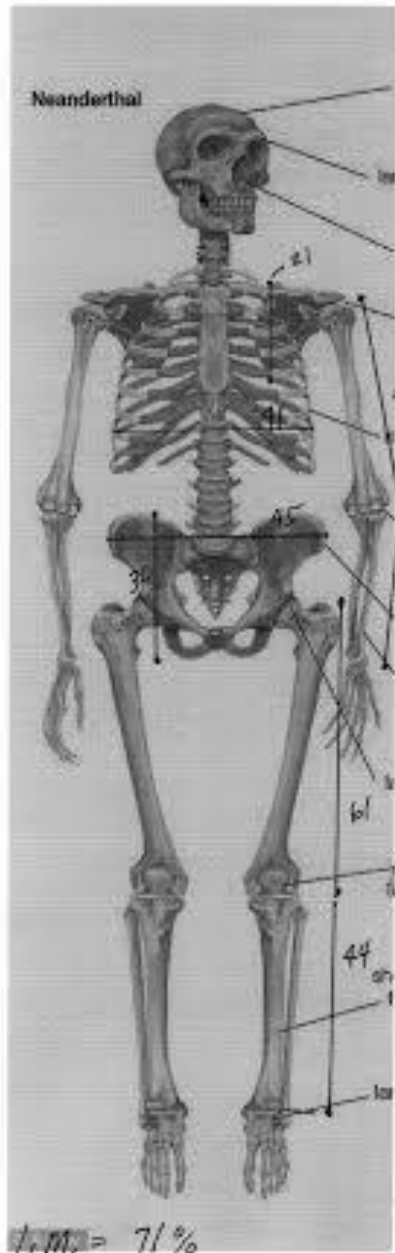




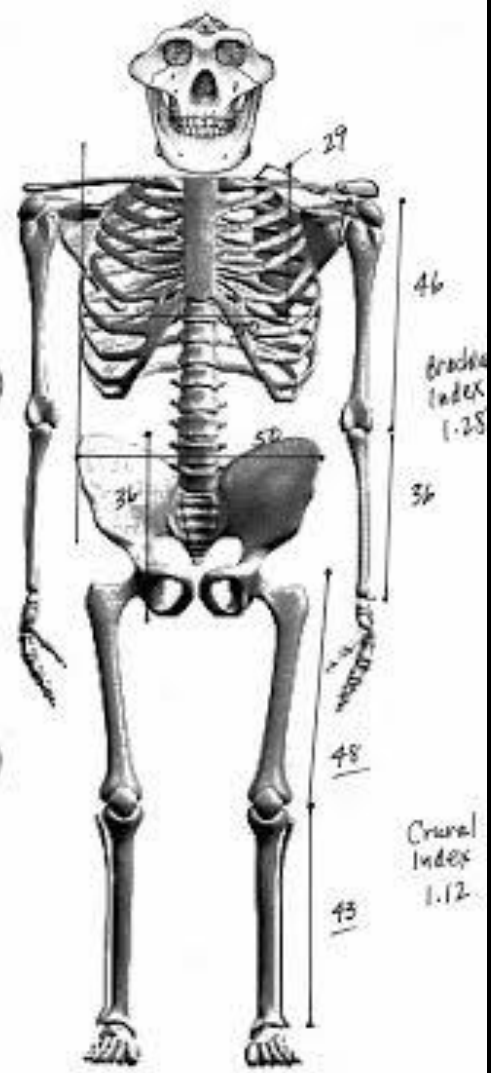
DIMENSIONS OF THE PATTERSON SASQUATCH

The measurements above are taken from Roger Patterson's movie of a Northern California Sasquatch, using the known length of the footprint, 14 1/2 inches, as a standard. Since the picture is blurred and the creature has a fur coat of unknown thickness, the measurements are not exact. Position of joints is estimated from the motion of the limbs. Measurements from the back are considerably less exact than from the side, as this view of the creature in the film is at a much greater distance. The approximate height is verified by comparisons made at the spot where the film was taken.



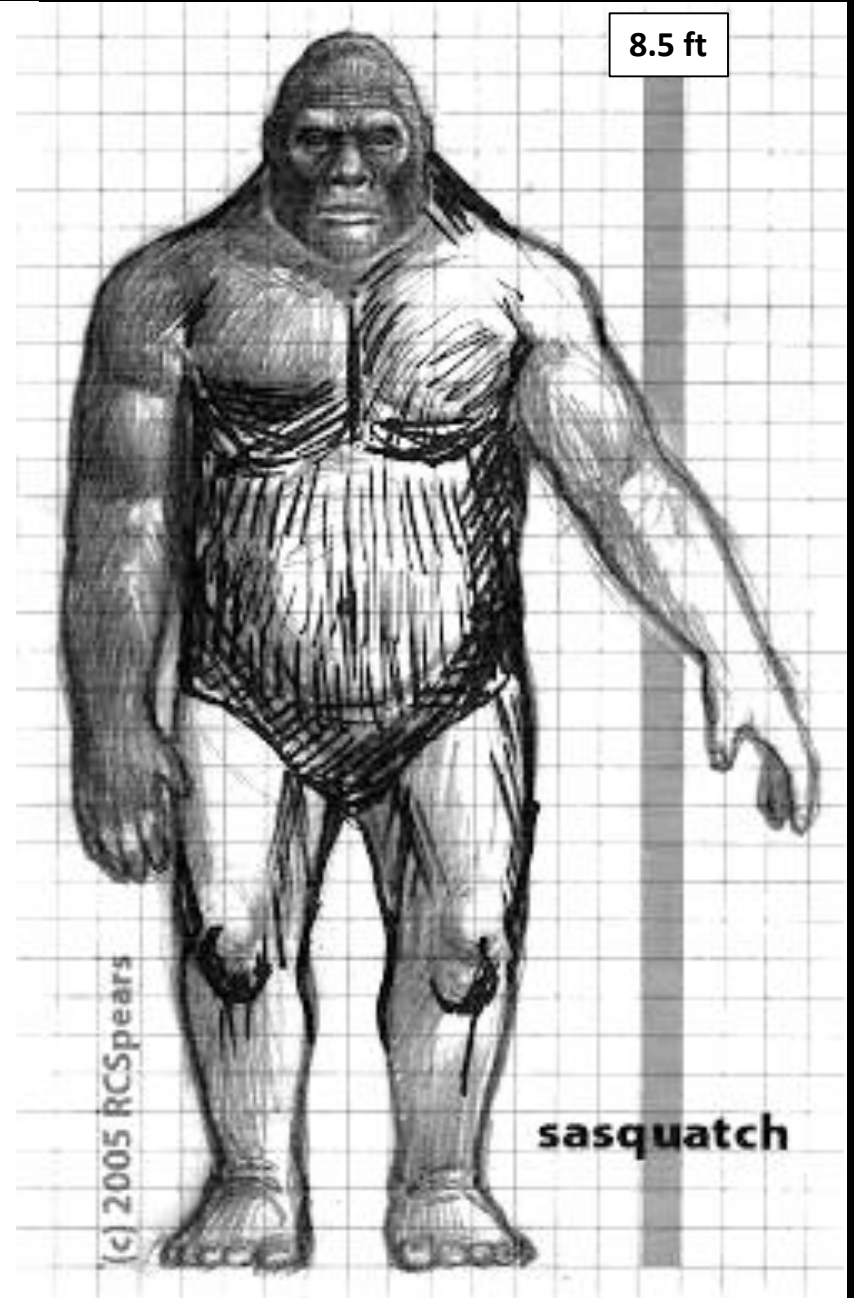
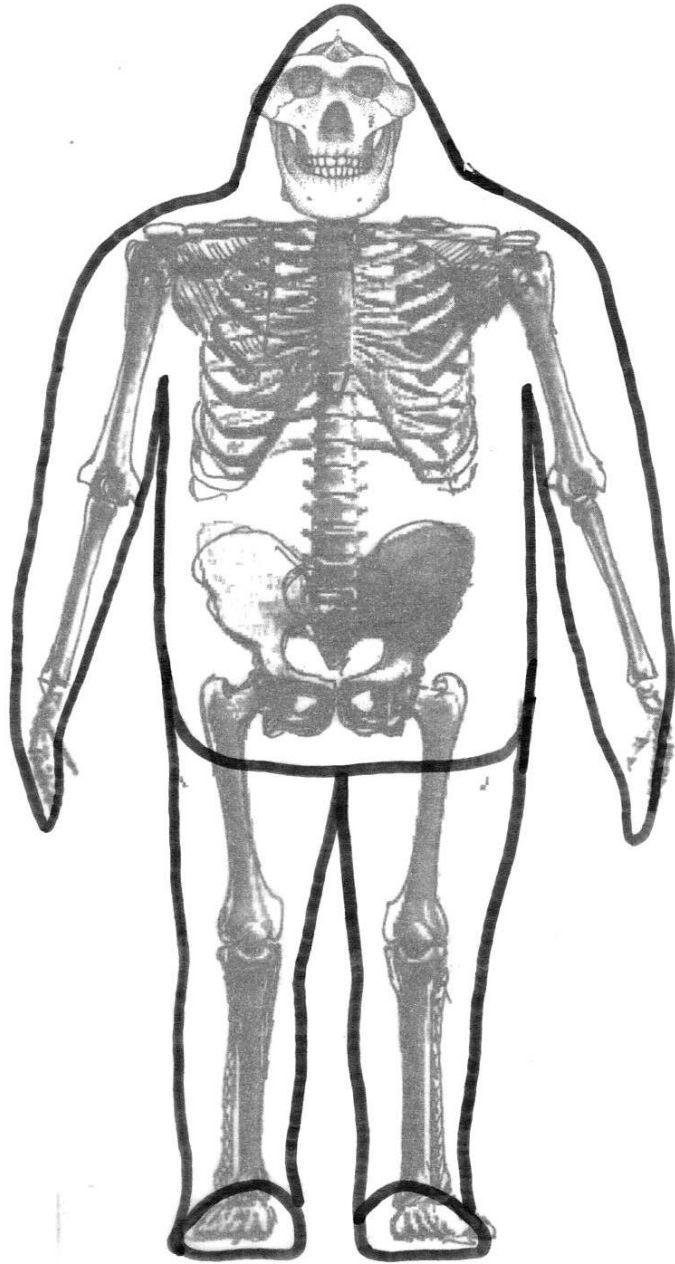
